RSS Attendance History Report

The RSS Attendance History report provides data on Regularly Scheduled Series (RSS) attendance, with attendance numbers.

This report is used by CE/CME administrators and accreditation staff to:

- View attendance trends by session date
- View attendance in each session and download a roster of participants
- View the number of "unique participants" that attended the series

Accessing the RSS Attendance History Report

- 1. Sign in to the CE Portal; scroll to the bottom to select **Administration**.
- 2. From the main menu, select **Reports**, then **RSS Attendance History**.


Viewing Data

- 1. Enter the name of the Regularly Scheduled Series in the activity search field. Narrow the search results by providing a **First Credit Date** and a **Last Credit Date** (if needed).
- Enter the search criteria and click the Run Report button.




Charting Trends

The plot chart will display the actual attendance numbers for the activity on the **Attendance History** tab. Each data point on the chart represents a session.




Viewing Details

The **Attendance Data** tab will display additional data points such as the child activity date, the attendance total, the title of the child activity, and the child ID number.




Click the **Roster** link to display a pop-up window with the Attendance Roster for the specific date. Information from the Data table and Attendance Roster can be exported to an Excel file by clicking the **Export XLS** button.




View Who Attended throughout the Year
